⁽¹⁾ Please note that direct debit offers you an easier manageability. Also if you choose this means of payment, we grant you a 1% discount on the invoiced amount.

⁽²⁾ "A tartiniste is a pupil who brings his own sandwich or cold meal in school restaurant. This tartiniste meal cannot be reheated on microwave." This amount is decided by the Board of the European School and the Canteen Committee. This is a mandatory contribution for tap water, napkins and cups available for the primary "tartiniste". This amount is part of the contract between the European School and Eurest. **The "tartiniste" package is only possible at the European School.**

General conditions



<u>Enrolment</u>

Enrolment to the catering service is compulsory for all pupils of the nursery or primary cycle attending school and/or the CPE. Enrolment is on done for a school year and renewable by tacit agreement. The online enrolment form for the school year 2017-2018 must be completed in full and validated by the 15th of August at latest. Registration at the beginning of the school year is compulsory in order to attend the school restaurant.

Invoicing and payment

Invoicing is semi-annual. Invoices will be available directly on your user interface (<u>https://eel2.eurest.lu</u>) at the end of October for meals concerning the first semester and at the beginning of March for meals concerning the second semester. Invoices will be paid either by direct debit or by bank transfer.

In case of direct debit payment, a discount of 1% will be granted. The new online SEPA Direct Debit form is fillable online. As soon as parents have validated the S2D form, EUREST is hereby authorized to proceed to debit the both invoices of October and March and that without revocation notification, modification and / or school leaving, the mandate is valid repeatedly.

An invoice must be disputed in writing to the company within a maximum of thirty (30) days from the issuance date of the said invoice. Any late complaint shall be considered as unacceptable by the company.

Furthermore, any invoice unpaid on its due date shall be automatically and without prior formal notice be increased by an additional fixed indemnity of the sums dues, without prejudice to the right of the seller to claim additional damages. The names of the enrolled children will be communicated to EUREST by the CPE administration.

School holiday period (only for children enrolled in the CPE)

The enrolment for meals during the school holidays (except summer holidays) is done with the enrolment via the site "E-KidReg" of the CPE. Those meals are included in the price of the "CPE package". For the secondary children and troubleshooting register, an invoice will be sent separately to the parents.

Summer holiday period (only for children enrolled in the CPE)

The enrolment for meals during the summer holidays is done with the enrolment via the site "E-KidReg" of the CPE. In addition, parents have to register on-line with Eurest (the link will be sent by the CPE administration to all parents) respecting the enrolment limit communicated by the CPE. A package price per week is established. An invoice concerning this period, on the basis of the enrolment to the CPE, will be sent to the parents at the end of the summer holidays. Payment must be made upon reception of the invoice by bank transfer. The names of the enrolled children will be communicated to Eurest by the CPE administration.

Modification of package

A modification of the package can be requested until the end of the previous semester via your user interface (<u>https://eel2.eurest.lu</u>). Only one change is allowed per school year.

First semester: 5th of September – 31st of January

Second semester: 1st of February – 6th of July

Reimbursement

A reimbursement request may be made at the latest before the end of the semester via the form relating to the catering service of European School Luxembourg II (available online <u>https://eel2.eurest.lu</u>). Only in the following cases:

- In case of a consecutive absence, starting from the sixth consecutive working day, the document must be accompanied by proof of absence established by the European School and/or a medical certificate for the CPE.

- If your child leaves the school and/or the CPE, a reimbursement amount will be calculated, based on the number of meals not consumed during the trimester.

- In case of a change of the attendance during the summer holiday period, provided that the justified absence lasts at least 5 consecutive working days and notification was given via "E-KidReg" to the CPE Administration at least 10 working days in advance. The refund request must be made at the end of the summer holiday period.

Confidentiality of data

EUREST uses any data received exclusively for the purposes for which it is intended: the invoicing and collection of catering fees concerning the European School Luxembourg II and CPE. Eurest ensures that the data shall under no circumstances be transmitted to third parties. The data will be destroyed at the end of the legal period.
