- Availability: Candidates must be available for the school year 2020-2021;
- Removal costs: in accordance to articles 37 & 38 of the Service regulations, the locally recruited teachers recruited for a minimum period of one year, are entitled to reimbursement of their removal expenses;
- Under certain conditions we pay an installation allowance equal to one month salary;
- School fees: a reduction in school fees shall be granted during the period of their employment for any of their children enrolled in the European Schools. (Cf.: article 39 of the Service regulations).
