## The Calendar

**November**: Your child's teacher will meet you for a short oral assessment to give you an overview of the evolution of your child during the term.

Each teacher organizes these interviews independently.

**Monday 09/11:** Pedagogical Day, no class for the pupils.

**Class photos:** the individual photos will be taken from 10/11 until 19/11. The exact date will be communicated by your child's teacher. Regarding the package and sales conditions, please refer to the specific communication on this subject.

**Tuesday 10/11 > Tuesday 24/11:** Students can participate in our traditional Christmas card contest. Your child's teacher will inform him/her.

## Arrival of the Primary pupils from 8.15 to 8.40:

From Tuesday 10/11, Primary students will enter through gate 2. This is located between the Nursery building and the Primary building. The entrance for Nursery students will remain gate 3 (from 8.15 to 8.40). The reception arrangements do not change. Students must always return to their recreation area.

The exit of the pupils at the end of the day remains unchanged. It is always done through portal 3.

## Miscellaneous

**Fruit4school:** as every year the school participates in Fruit4school program <a href="http://portal.education.lu/fruit4school/">http://portal.education.lu/fruit4school/</a>. Each week the fruits are distributed to students. This program starts in October.

**Additional supervision staff:** Due to the current situation and the many constraints it imposes, we have recruited additional supervision staff for our two cycles Nursery and Primary. These people will take up their duties from Tuesday 10/11. In particular, they will be in charge of supervising students during the breaks, in the corridors as well as at the start and end of the school day.

**Students' behavior:** It is not uncommon for us to learn about certain inappropriate behaviors of our students on school buses. Raising awareness of respect for the rules of community life is of course part of the daily work of teachers. The collaboration of parents in this area is essential. So thank you, if appropriate, for discussing it with your child.

**Hours:** As a reminder, the school gates close at 8.40 each morning. If you are late, please bring your child directly to the main entrance of the building concerned. Thank you for respecting this important time for the smooth running of the courses. Regarding bus delays, we obviously manage them.

I take this first newsletter to highlight the work and unfailing commitment of the entire team (teachers, secretariat...) of the Nursery-Primary cycle to ensure the best reception of our students in the current circumstances. I thank them.
