Profile

- The candidates will be a native English speaker (mother tongue level or C2).
- Qualifications to teach English as foreign language will be considered as an asset.
- Previous experience as teacher in the Primary school and knowledge of at least one of the other working languages of the European School of Luxembourg II (French, German) are an asset.
- Experience and qualification to teach to students with special educational needs will be considered as an asset.
- The candidates will be motivated to work in a team together with the other teachers and pedagogical staff of the Primary cycle.
- The candidates will be willing to acquire the necessary knowledge for the effective use of the European Schools' specific software.
- The candidates will have knowledge of the European School system and be motivated to work in a multilingual and multicultural environment.
- The candidates will have a strong sense of responsibility and an impeccable personal presentation.
