- The candidates will be a native English speaker (mother tongue level or C2).
- Qualifications to teach English as foreign language will be considered as an asset.
- Previous experience as teacher in the Nursery school is an asset.
- Knowledge of at least one of the other working languages of the European School of Luxembourg II (French, German) is mandatory.
- Knowledge of any other language is an asset.
- Experience and qualification to teach to students with specific educational needs will be considered as an asset.
- The candidates will be motivated to work in a team together with the other teachers and pedagogical staff of the Primary cycle.
- The candidates will be willing to acquire the necessary knowledge for the effective use of the European Schools' specific software.
- The candidates will have knowledge of the European School system and be motivated to work in a multilingual and multicultural environment.
- The candidates will have a strong sense of responsibility and an impeccable personal presentation.
- The candidate has to be an EU citizen or be in possession of an authorization to work in the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg at the time of the application.
